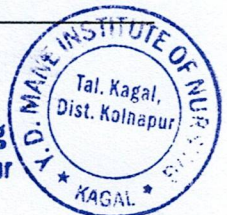

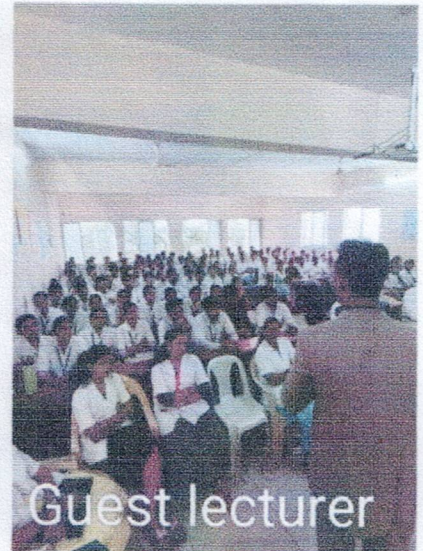

A guest lecture on "Sensitization on HIV/AIDS" was organized on 11th October 2025 at Y.D. Mane Institute of Nursing, Kagal. The program was arranged for B.Sc. Nursing 3rd Semester and GNM 1st Year students. On behalf of our respected Principal Prof. Mr. Juberahmed Sanadi, the session was graciously observed by our Vice Principal Prof. Mr. Rohan Phaphe.

The guest lecture aimed to create awareness among nursing students about HIV/AIDS, its causes, prevention, and the importance of counseling and laboratory diagnosis in early detection and control.

The session was led by Mr. Dhanaji Patil, who shared his 19 years of experience in counseling and sensitization related to HIV/AIDS. He addressed students on various important aspects including:

➤ **Causing Factors:**

He explained that HIV (Human Immunodeficiency Virus) is mainly transmitted through unprotected sexual contact, sharing of infected needles, blood transfusion, and from mother to child during birth or breastfeeding.

➤ **Prevention:**

The importance of safe sex practices, use of sterilized needles, screening of blood before transfusion, and public education were emphasized. He encouraged students to actively participate in spreading awareness and eliminating myths associated with HIV/AIDS.

➤ **Laboratory Tests:**

Mr. Pradip Desai, Laboratory Technician from Rural Hospital, Kagal, described various laboratory diagnostic methods such as ELISA, Western Blot, and Rapid Tests used for detection

➤ **Privileges and Commitment:**


